The LITPC Hall of Fame

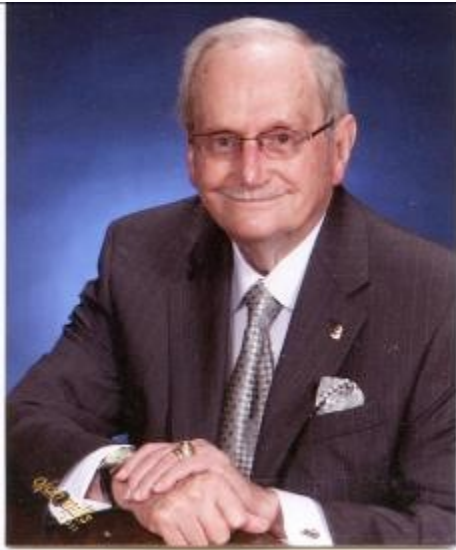
After several years of consideration, the LITPC Board of Directors, in 2000, and under the leadership of President **Dave Harris** of Virginia, adopted a recognition program for outstanding members that was proposed by Third Vice President **Jim Schiebel** of New York. The criteria established by the Awards Committee, which was chaired by Third Vice President Jim Schiebel, evaluated a member's contributions to the LITPC and their personal ethical behavior. At the Annual Meeting in Ocean City, Maryland, five members were inducted into the newly established LITPC Hall of Fame. Since then, this has rapidly become the most coveted honor that a pin trader can achieve.

The LITPC Hall of Fame

All members of the LITPC Hall of Fame are shown in the order in which they were inducted. The policy which establishes the LITPC Hall of Fame stipulates that this is the highest award that can be bestowed upon a member of the LITPC. The provisions of the policy provides that there shall be no more than two living individuals honored in a given year, one of whom should be a "rank and file" member of the LITPC. Also, there shall be no more than one, if any, posthumously honored individual in a given year. Since this is planned as a "living history" of the LITPC, we will be able to update this listing on an annual basis. we are showing the Hall of Fame Members that have been inducted to date. Once again, they are shown in the order selected by the Committee.

It should be noted here that since his induction into the Hall of Fame, Lion **Harry Fulwiler**, Virginia, has served as the co-chair for the LITPC Hall of Fame Committee and, as such, has functioned as the administrator of the Hall of Fame. He has taken a keen interest in assuring that the strict rules for voting and selection are carried out. He deserves much credit for the continued success of this important activity.

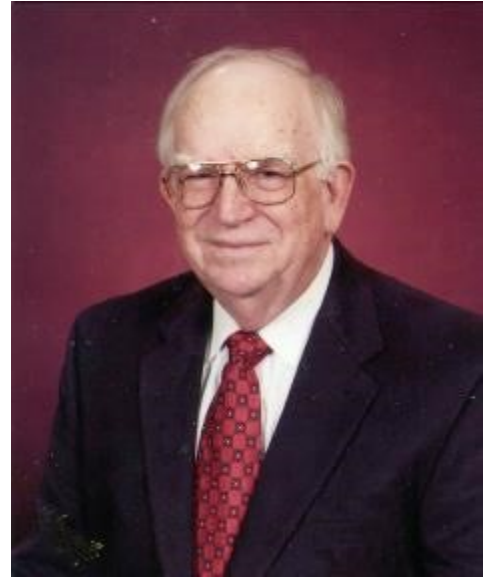

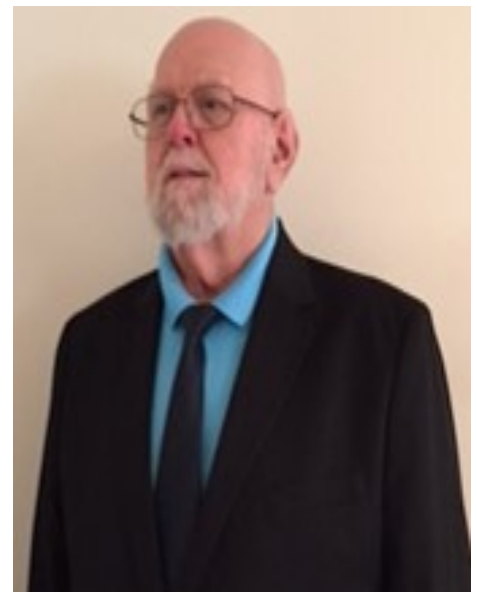
