These are actually “Distinguished Service Awards” that were presented in very limited quantities and would not normally be shown in this catalog. However, because of the designation “MD-24, VIRGINIA”, we recognize that eventually some will become available on the trading market and we feel they should be documented. Most traders will not be able to obtain them. The images have been reduced by 50% to conserve space. Beginning in 2015, the medal was standardized with the names of the current Council of Governors on the reverse of the medal.
