LIONS CLUB CLIP-ON TIES



This catalog contains the Lions Clubs Clip-On Ties. The ties were issued in the late 1960s and early 1970s. As far as can be determined, they were issued by each State and Canada. Until now they have not been documented even though they have the medallion with the name of the State/Country and a place for a Lions emblem to be affixed. Each tie has a plastic insert that permitted the wearer to affix the tie up under the shirt collar. The tie is affixed to a medallion which has the lettering to denote the name of the State, e.g., "State of Alabama". There is a small hole in the middle of the medallion which permits the insertion of the Lions lapel emblem. Many have the screw-back fastener, which was common in the 1960s. It is not known how many different color ties were issued by the individual States. An example of the medallion is shown below.



The ties in this catalog have all been rethe ties measure from top of the bow to the bottom of the medallion, 7 1/2" x 2 1/4".
